


WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR YOUNG PEOPLE?





There is **10.5 billion euros** to work with here, so let's see what this means for the younger generation of Ireland!



Some of these changes will **take effect immediately** or **before the end of 2024.** Other changes will be **implemented in the new year.**





FOR THE STUDENTS...

There is a **free school book scheme** to be implemented for **Junior Cycle students.**



Postgraduate students will now receive **maintenance grants** again, just like undergraduate students do!



An additional **50 million euro** has been allocated to the **school transport scheme.**



Parents who pay for their children's rent in University can claim a tax credit of 750 euro.



WORKERS MAY NOTICE SOME CHANGES TO THEIR PAYSLIPS!

The Budget 2025 has added a..

ર્ફ 100 increase in **Personal Tax Credit.**

ર્દ્ર 100 increase in **PAYE Tax Credit.**

67 million euro has been provided for 16,000 craft **apprenticeship programmes.**

The national **minimum wage** will increase by 1.40 euro per hour to **12.70 euro per hour.**



More young people will qualify for **cheaper public transport fares** under the new changes, **24 and 25 year olds** will be eligible for the **Young Adult Card** for the first time, allowing **half price fares** on public transport!
